*Compulsory* – always on schedule and are held annually on a regular basis *Elective* – optional and offered only if 20 students are registered




HSE University places no restrictions on choice of MA level courses for BA students


**NB!** HSE University grades are <u>cumulative</u>. The grade composition for each discipline is defined in the **course syllabus**
