What do they do?	provide support regarding general study issues: — Learning Management System (LMS); — HSE University e-mail password recovery; — Your study plan (course drop/course enrolment)	provide support regarding a particular course: — syllabus; — schedule; — accepting / declining enrollment request.

What kind of courses are there at HSE University?

Types of courses

Compulsory – always on schedule and are held annually on a regular basis Elective – optional and offered only if 20 students are registered

- All courses are free for exchange students

Fill in <u>Course drop form</u> and sign it at CISM (Online Document Request)



E-mail signed <u>Course drop form</u> to your study manager (in *cc* CISM)

NB! Students are advised to take not less than 15 ECTS and not more than 45 ECTS


