### 1 Rate location

The proximity of the metro, bus stops, shops, the University and other facilities

### 2 Clarify payment terms

Is a deposit required, do you need to pay extra for utilities, etc.

### **3** Learn about the apartment

Quality of repair and furniture, availability of everything necessary for a comfortable stay



### 4 Realtor or owner?

You can conclude an agreement with the owner directly and you don't have to pay a commission to the realtor



### Clarify about the registration

It is necessary to check with the owner about the registration in advance

### What documents are required for check-in?

- Printed Accommodation Referral;
- Passport (+ copy) or ID (+ copy);
- Migration Card (+ copy);
- Medical Documents:
- Certificate with a list of vaccinations or a copy of a vaccination certificate;
- Health certificate bought before entry to Russia
- a document confirming a negative test result for Covid-19 by PCR.

# **Medical Issues**

### Medical Insurance (VHI policy)

All foreign citizens in Russia should have medical insurance

to cover their entire stay in Russia

### 14 days self-isolation

After arriving and moving into a dormitory/apartment/hotel, within the next **14 day you must self-isolate.** 



#### Where to self-isolate?

dormitory / apartment / hotel

#### Can I go outside?

You are only permitted to leave the room to visit a polyclinic, go to a pharmacy or store for necessary goods.

### **Medical Certificates**

**BEFORE ARRIVAL TO RUSSIA:** 

Negative test result for Covid-19 (by PCR)

Present at the checkpoint when crossing the border and

when checking into a dormitory. The COVID-19 test must

be made no earlier than 3 days before arriving in Russia.

#### Vaccination Certificate

Must be issued by a medical institution in a free format

with information about the inoculation had, as well as

dates and types of vaccination.

# AFTER ARRIVAL TO RUSSIA:

Medical Examination (on 10<sup>th</sup> day after arrival)

you should have a medical examination and get a repeat

testing for COVID-19 (using the PCR-method)

#### IF ALREADY ON THE TERRITORY OF RUSSIA:

Medical Examination (before the academic year starts)

you should have a medical examination. It is also recommended to get

testing for COVID-19 (using the PCR-method).


